

## No Walls? No Problem: Ceiling Mounting Your TV

The trend for open-plan living in Ireland shows no sign of slowing down. We are knocking down walls, installing floor-to-ceiling glass, and creating vast, airy kitchen-dining-living spaces. It looks spectacular, but it creates a specific problem: where do you put the TV?

If one wall is glass, another is the kitchen cabinets, and the third is a feature fireplace, you often run out of wall space. Putting the TV on a stand in the middle of the room blocks the flow and looks cluttered. The architectural solution is to look up. Ceiling mounting allows you to position the TV exactly where you want it, independent of the walls.

### The "Floating" Aesthetic

A ceiling-mounted TV feels incredibly modern. It floats in space, keeping the floor area completely clear. This is particularly effective in bedrooms at the foot of the bed, or in large living areas where you want to zone the space without building a partition wall.

The pole drops down from the ceiling, concealing all the cables inside. The TV can then be rotated 360 degrees. This is a massive functional benefit. You can watch the news from the kitchen island while cooking, then spin the TV around to face the sofa for the evening movie. It makes one TV do the work of two.

### Structural Considerations

Hanging a heavy TV from the ceiling is not a DIY job. Gravity is working against you. If the fixings fail, the TV falls straight down.

Professional [Ireland TV hanging](#) services locate the structural joists or concrete slab in the ceiling. We do not hang TVs from plasterboard or suspended ceilings alone. If the joists are not in the right place, we go into the ceiling void and install timber bridging (unistrut or noggin) to create a secure anchor point. Safety is the absolute priority.

### Automated Flip-Down Mounts

For those who want the view to be the priority, motorised flip-down mounts are the ultimate luxury. These fold the TV flat against the ceiling when not in use, hiding it completely.

When you press the remote, the TV silently lowers into viewing position. This is perfect for rooms with amazing views of the garden or the sea, where you don't want a black screen blocking the glass during the day. It preserves the architectural integrity of the room while providing entertainment on demand.

### Managing Height and Glare

Ceiling mounts allow for precise height adjustment. Telescopic poles mean we can lower the TV to the perfect eye level, even in rooms with vaulted or cathedral ceilings.

Because the TV is hanging in open space, glare from windows can be an issue. The ability to swivel and tilt the screen is vital here. We can angle the screen away from the sun, ensuring a clear picture at any time of day. It offers a flexibility that fixed wall mounts simply cannot match.
